What is The Pantry?

The Pantry is a community pantry. It is a great place to shop for cost effective food, share recipes and have meaningful conversations. It is filled with generously donated items and groceries sourced from suppliers that help us keep the prices low for our Pantry Members.

Why does The Pantry exist?

The cost of living is rising in Australia. It's understandable that people from all walks of life are looking for ways to make their budget go further. The Pantry is designed to help out with the food budget and create an important community connection point.

Who can shop at The Pantry?

Each time we set up The Pantry we will often think about the living situation of people in single income or low income households, because we know the difference that a visit to The Pantry can make.

A common misconception is that you have to be in financial trouble to access a food care program like ours – you don't. We greatly encourage everyone to visit. We are a generous community who will always share what we have. We love the opportunity to meet with locals and make new friends - so don't be shy.

How does it work?

1. Become a member of The Pantry

For just \$2 you will receive a six month membership to The Pantry with the option to renew.

2. Select your groceries

Choose from a range of low-cost healthy foods and other necessities.

3. Sit down and have break

You're welcome to stay for a tea or coffee or a light snack. Our volunteers like to share recipe ideas, and talk about life. Kids can enjoy a bit of play time.

4. Give us your feedback

Your feedback is important to us. It will inform us on what we do well and what can be improved.
